WHEN SOMEONE PASSES AWAY

When someone passes away, there are several steps that need to be taken care of.

If your loved one dies at home: Getting the Medical Certificate

If your loved one passes away at home, the first step will be to call their doctor. If the doctor decides there is no need to contact the coroner, they will supply the local Registrar with a Medical Certificate of Cause of Death. Thereafter, you will need to contact us as your chosen the funeral director to arrange bringing the deceased into our care.

What if the doctor does not agree to sign the death certificate?

If the doctor does not agree to sign the death certificate or there is an inquest, they will refer to the coroner and a post-mortem may need to take place which will take a bit longer. If this is the case, contact us and we will talk you through the next steps.

If your loved one dies elsewhere:

In Hospital: the hospital team will liaise with the doctor on your behalf, and your doctor will advise you on the next steps, and when to give us a call.

Care Home or Hospice: the care staff will usually liaise with the doctor or practice nurse in the first instance. The process remains the same as above.

On holiday or outside of the UK: If this occurs, contact us as soon as possible and we can arrange for repatriation to bring your loved one back home.

Who can register the death?

Death is usually registered by the next of kin or a relative of the deceased. Alternatively, this can be done by the person who was with the deceased at the time of their death or the person who is arranging the funeral.

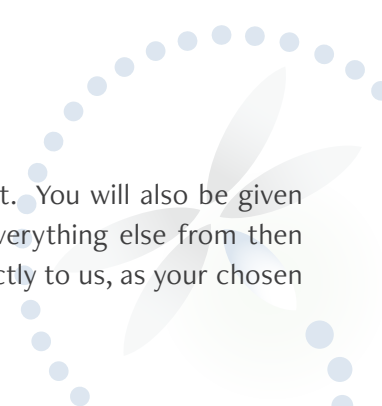
What to prepare: What documents do I need for death registration?

Contact the registrar who will make an appointment to register the death. They will need certain key information including:

- Full name, gender, date and country of birth
- Occupation: current or previous
- Address and postcode
- Parental names and occupations
- Marital status with partner(s) name, date of birth and occupation

What documents to expect:

Once the registration has taken place, the death certificate will be sent out to you by post. You will also be given a “Green Form” to hand over to us at your earliest convenience. We will take care of everything else from then on. If a post-mortem has been carried out, the coroner will issue a Form 6 Certificate directly to us, as your chosen funeral director.



TELL US ONCE

We recommend using the ‘Tell Us Once’ service available through GOV.UK. This allows you to report a death to most government organisations in one go. If you have any other questions, please call us.

BEFORE THE FUNERAL

It's almost impossible to be fully prepared when the time comes, however, there are a few things you need to consider when planning the funeral.

Burial or Cremation

A key decision is whether to arrange a burial or cremation. If you know what the deceased wanted, let us know. If you are unsure, you may wish to check their will or expression of wishes or talk to friends and other family members. You must also check if the deceased had taken out a funeral plan.

Religious or non-religious service

Another important consideration is whether the deceased was religious or a member of a specific place of worship. You would likely want to arrange the funeral following his/her faith; if so, please do let us know.

Repatriation

If your loved one passes away whilst abroad, they can be repatriated back to their home country if needed. Repatriation can be to and from the UK. We offer guidance and help throughout the entire repatriation process to ensure that your loved one is brought back home to be buried or cremated.

DAY OF THE FUNERAL

This is the day you pay a unique tribute to the life of your loved one. Depending on your choice, the day typically includes Funeral Procession, Funeral Ceremony, Burial or Cremation and a Wake (reception).

Funeral Procession

On the day itself, we will arrive at our agreed meeting point in good time so you can view any floral tributes before leaving for the service. Family and friends who are traveling in our funeral limousines will need to arrive at the agreed location before we start the procession. On arrival at the funeral venue, our professional pallbearers or your loved one's family and friends will escort the coffin with dignity and respect into the service hall led by our funeral director.

Funeral Ceremony

The ceremony will start at the time booked for you, following the pre-arranged order of service. Every funeral ceremony is completely unique to every family. Traditionally, close family will sit in the first few rows, however you can arrange the seating as you would like.

After the service, we will show you to the area where the flowers and floral tributes will be placed.

Burial or Cremation

If you have held the service at a separate place of worship prior to burial or cremation, we will escort you to the next destination for the committal.

Wake (reception)

Many families choose to hold a catered reception following the funeral. Friends and family come together to reminisce and celebrate the life of the deceased. You can organise the reception at your home or at another venue, it is up to you.

AFTER THE FUNERAL

After the funeral service, many families choose to commemorate their loved ones by having a memorial or keepsake to keep their memories alive. If you'd like to do something special after the service do let us know – we're happy to help!

Following a Cremation

If we have arranged a cremation service for you, we can arrange to collect the ashes on your behalf free of charge and hold them in our care until you decide what you would like to do.

Many families choose to commemorate the ashes immediately, others prefer waiting until a special day or an opportunity when the entire family can come together.

Should you wish to keep your loved one's ashes with you, we have a selected range of urns available to keep the ashes safe in your home as well as a range of keepsakes and ashes and fingerprint jewellery.

Following a burial

If your loved one was buried, it can take 12-18 months for the grave to settle. This means organising a fitting memorial headstone can take a bit of time and needs consideration well in advance. Please give us a call and we'd be more than happy to answer any questions you may have. We're here for you.

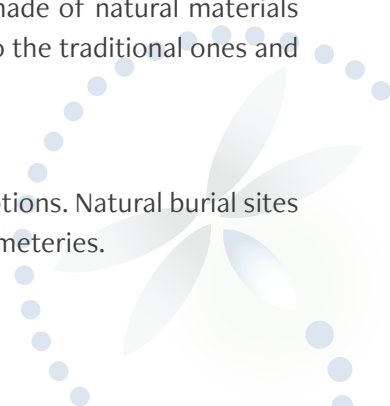

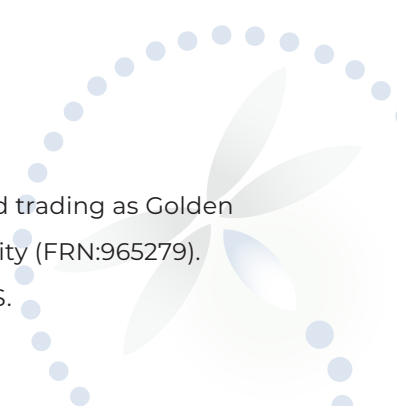

FAQ's

In our opinion there is no such thing as a normal funeral. Each and every funeral is individual to the family concerned. It is up to that family to pay their last respects and say their last farewell in the manner that is most suitable for them. The following information is there to help answer questions that we are most often asked about the funeral and services associated with it :-

(Q). What are Doctors Forms ?

(A). When a funeral is a cremation, two doctors must attend & certify death. The first doctor must be the doctor who attended the deceased during his/her last illness. The duty of the second doctor is one of confirmation. This doctor must not be related to the first doctor either through family or practice. For this service, each doctor makes a separate charge, which we usually pay on behalf of the deceased's family.

(Q). How Many People Can Be Seated In The Limousine ?

(A). In each limousine there is room for six people in the rear compartment and room for one in the front.

(Q). How Do We Know What To Do At The Funeral ?

(A). On the day of the funeral we are there to help and guide you, your family and friends. If you are unsure of anything please tell the Funeral Director.

(Q). Can The Family Carry The Coffin ?

(A). Yes, although we would ask that you contact us as soon as possible to ensure that it is safe to do so.

(Q). Can We Visit The Deceased And Pay Our Last Respects ?

(A). Yes, our Funeral Home is available to you by appointment. If you wish to visit our private chapel, please ring and inform us when you would like to come and we will be pleased to arrange for a member of staff to meet you.

(Q). Can We Have The Deceased Brought Home ?

(A). Yes, we can bring the deceased home either on the evening before the service or the morning of the service.

(Q). Can We Choose What Music Is Played At The Crematorium ?

(A). Yes, If you have a special request or would like a particular piece of music playing either as you walk into or out of the Crematorium Chapel, please let the Funeral Director know.

(Q). Can We Request Donations To Charity ?

(A). Yes, if donations to charity are requested in lieu of flowers, we will accept and list donations on your behalf and forward them to the charity of your choice.

(Q). Does The Coffin Move After The Funeral Service At The Crematorium ?

(A). No. After the service has ended, the coffin does not move until all relatives and friends have left the Crematorium Chapel. At some Crematoria there are curtains that close at the head of the coffin, but this is only done at the request of the relatives.

(Q). Are The Handles On The Coffin Removed Before The Cremation Takes Place ?

(A). No. There are strict laws regarding cremation. Nothing may be removed from the coffin before cremation without the permission of the Home Office.

(Q). Is Each Cremation Carried Out Individually ?

(A). Yes. The identity of the coffin name plate is checked by the Crematorium Attendant before it is placed in the Cremation Chamber. This only holds one coffin or casket at a time and again there are rules that must be abided by.

(Q). Do I Get The Cremated Remains Back That Belong To Me ?

(A). Yes. Once the cremation has taken place, the cremated remains are removed and left to cool before being placed in an urn. This urn is clearly identified as to whose remains they are.

(Q). What Can I Do With The Cremated Remains ?

1. You can place them in the Garden of Remembrance but you may not know where they are and you can not place a headstone with them.
2. You may wish to purchase a grave just for the purpose of interring the cremated remains. This allows you to have a headstone and have other members of the family buried there in the future.
3. You may keep them at home in a special urn or memorial.
4. You may scatter them in a special place.
5. The remains may be buried in an existing family grave.

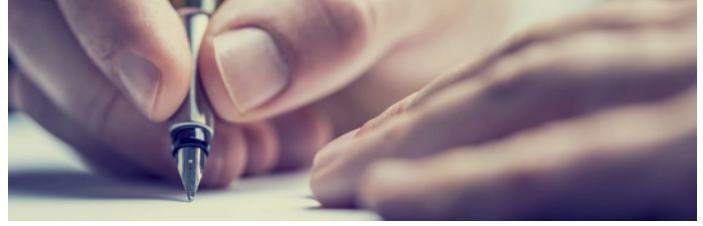

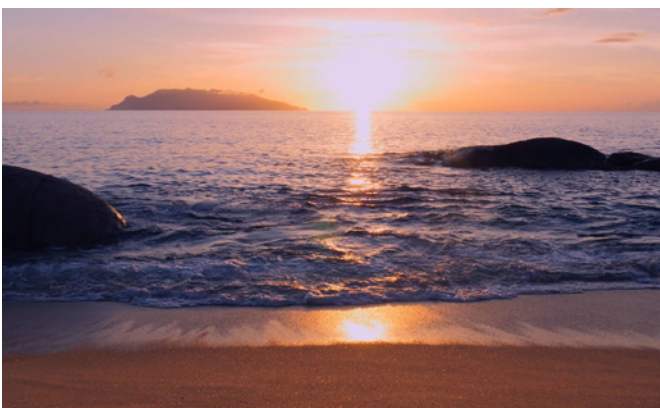
